Apply as needed, beginning when conditions are favorable for disease development.
	Diplodia Tip Blight Sphaeropsis sapinea	For diplodia tip blight and tip blight, make 3 applications every 14 days prior to major period of infection. Application should be started at the initiation of new growth. For juniper phomopsis blight, make first application as soon as junipers start to grow, and repeat the applications every 14-21 days during periods of active growth. Can be use as a tank mix or rotation 3336, Spectro, or Chlorothalonil.
